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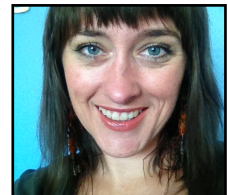

Upper Childhood C3

In 5th and 6th grade your child will have the opportunity to choose which C3 program they are most interested in. Using a lottery based system and prioritizing for volunteer participation, children are placed in modules based in visual arts, performing arts, or community based curriculum (CBC).
