

Days 1-2 JFK/France: Depart for France today. On arrival you will transfer to the historic city of Annecy for two nights. The setting is breathtaking with a beautiful lake and the Alps as a backdrop. **(D,B) D**

Day 3 Annecy: This morning enjoy a tour of this historic city dating back to 1110 and is often referred to as the “Venice of the Alps”. The town has something for everyone with amazing mountain views, flowery lanes, romantic canals and a château. **B**

Day 4—Perogues/Ship: Today travel to the villa of Perogues via countryside. Tour this ancient village. Afterwards continue to your ship, the Amadeus Symphony. Enjoy the next seven nights on this luxurious ship. Enjoy delightful cuisine, excellent service, gym, salon & more. **BD**

Day 5—Beaujolais: Spend the entire day in Macon, a picturesque town found perched on the banks of the river Saône in beautiful Burgundy countryside. You will partake in the Macon and Museum & Wine tour that includes wine-tasting and the romantic Beaujolais scenery, with its castles and vineyards, unfolds as you drive along the wine trail. After lunch have the chance to visit the Middle Ages Cluny abbey. **BLD**

Day 6-Burgundy: Dock for most of the day in Chalon-sur-Saône. Take the Burgundy vineyard tour. Drive to Beaune, the wine-growing centre and visit the Hotel-Dieu which dates back to the 15th century. During your wine-tasting learn the history and culture of

the region and famous tavern. After lunch you can visit the medieval villages of Brancion and Cormatin with its magnificent castle. **BLD**

Day 7—Lyon: Your guided tour of Lyon enables you to absorb the city’s important sights. The city has impressive elegant squares and ancient buildings. Later enjoy the views while cruising. **BLD**

Day 8—Avignon: Arrive this morning and tour one of the few city’s whose medieval walls have been almost completely preserved. The Popes who resided in Avignon were responsible for building its imposing Palais des Papes. Later wander this UNESCO village as the boat overnights. **BLD**

Day 9 —Arles: Located next by the Mediterranean you have 11 hours in this UNESCO city. Arles dates back to 1 B.C and boasts impressive Roman monuments. Your tour takes in the historical buildings in and around the historic village. **BLD**

Day 10 —Viviers: From Viviers you can visit one of France’s most interesting geographical features, the Ardèche gorge. Over several millennia waterpower has carved this gorge out through limestone. The coach will follow the river as it meanders through the gorge, which is 1,000 feet

deep in places, and you will see the famous Pont d Arc—a natural stone bridge that has become an icon for the Ardèche region. Tonight enjoy the Captain’s dinner. **BLD**

Day 11 —France/JFK: Transfer to the airport & fly home. **B (L)**
