HOME VISIT (May 10, 2014)

CONDITION OF HOME & OCCUPANTS: A follow up visit was conducted at the home of the current caregiver/ maternal grandmother with whom I

and are currently residing. The home is a one story, four bedroom, one and a half bathroom house. Eight people currently reside in the home; the two married caregivers, their 19 year old son, 18 year old son and the four children.

INTERACTION & OBSERVATION OF CHILD: The children were reported to have healthy appetites and sleep through the night. They were observed to be neatly dressed and clean. All four children were social and appeared happy. showed off cards they had made for their mother for mother's day.

NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN

MEDICAL & DENTAL: The children are covered by Medicaid. The children were reported to be current on their immunizations, doctor and dental visits. The caregiver reported all four children are diagnosed with asthma and use Albuteral and a nebulizer as needed was reported to still suffer from a hernia. She will continue to have the hernia monitored at routine doctor visits; however, surgery will not be contemplated until she reaches the age of five.

MENTAL HEALTH & THERAPUTIC SERVICES: No services are currently used.

and _____ completed their psychological evaluations in March 2014. No results have been obtained from the evaluations. _____ was reported to have completed his evaluation in early May 2014. The caregiver reported she was informed _____ will probably qualify for speech therapy.

SCHOOL: Both caregivers work full time. The children attend day care. Day care assistance is provided by CPS.

SUPERVISED VISITS: The mother was reported to visit the home a few days a week. The visits were reported as positive.

CONCERNS: There are no current concerns with the placement.

STRENGTHS: The caregiver appears to be providing for the children's needs.

RECOMMENDATION: The current placement is supported by the ad litem at this time.

AD LITEM'S STATUS REPORT

HOME VISIT (July 15, 2013)

CONDITION OF HOME & OCCUPANTS: A visit was conducted at the home of the current caregiver in which _____ are currently residing. The caregiver is the children's maternal grandmother. Photos are attached as exhibit A. The home is a one story, four bedroom, one and a half bathroom house. It was adequately furnished and maintained.

Eight people currently reside in the home; the two married caregivers, their 19 year old son, 18 year old son and the four children. _____ share a room and queen sized bed _____ sleeps in the caregiver's bedroom. Each adult son has his own room.

The home contains a bit pull dog. The dog appeared friendly. The caregiver reported she was instructed to remove the dog from the home by CPS. The home does contain an above ground pool. The caregiver reported she was instructed to dismantle the pool by CPS. The caregiver is willing and able to install the necessary locks on the doors leading to the pool.

INTERACTION & OBSERVATION OF CHILD: The children appeared clean and neatly dressed. They were extremely active. They were reported to have healthy

appetites and sleep through the night.

NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN

MEDICAL & DENTAL: The children are covered by Medicaid. [redacted] are in need of physicals. The children were reported to be current on their immunizations. All four children are in need of dental visits. The caregiver reported all four children are diagnosed with asthma and use Albuteral and a nebulizer as needed. [redacted] was reported to suffer from a hernia. The caregiver reported [redacted] hernia will be addressed at her physical.

MENTAL HEALTH & THERAPUTIC SERVICES: No services are currently used.

[redacted] was reported to be physically aggressive and often bites other members of the home, both children and adults. The caregiver exhibited several bite marks on her hands and forearms. The caregiver reported she will arrange a psychological evaluation for [redacted]. The caregiver reported [redacted] was previously on medication for her aggression.

SCHOOL: The children are currently cared for in the home by the caregiver's 18 year old son. It is suspected proper supervision is NOT being provided by the 18 year old. Both caregivers work full time. Day care assistance is desperately needed for the children.

SUPERVISED VISITS: The mother was reported to visit the home on a daily basis. The visits were reported as positive.

CONCERNS: There is a concern with the children care currently being provided.

STRENGTHS: The caregiver receives WIC for [redacted] and [redacted]. The caregiver has applied for food stamps. The caregiver reported she has filed for child support from the children's father.

RECOMMENDATION: The current placement is supported by the ad litem at this time.
