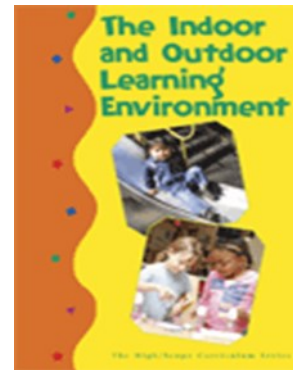

To support children's active learning, adults in early childhood programs set up the learning environment to provide children with plentiful materials and choices about how to use them. This means designing the overall learning space with different interest areas and labeling and storage systems that provide children easy access to the items they wish to use in their play. This media program includes examples from a variety of High Scope settings showing how adults can foster children's initiative and creativity through a supportive learning environment, both indoors and outdoors.

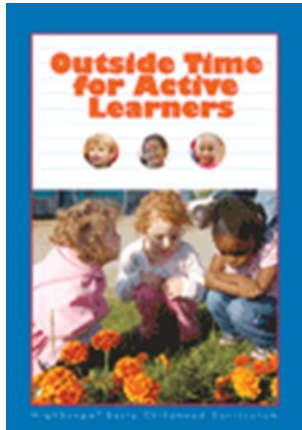

In the plan-do review process, children make plans, carry them out, and reflect on what they have done. In doing so, children learn to take initiative, solve problems, work with others, and accomplish their goals — their play becomes more purposeful and focused. 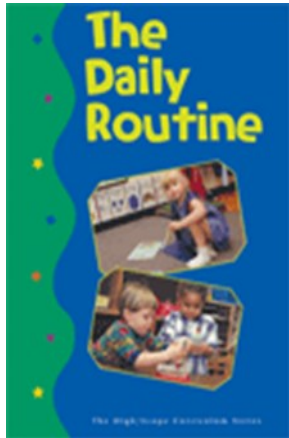

The program consists of two stand-alone sections, an overview of all parts of the daily routine and an extended example of a single daily routine in a High Scope early childhood program.

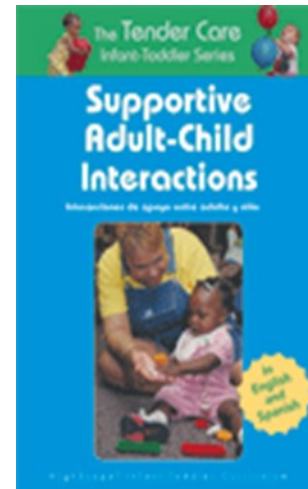
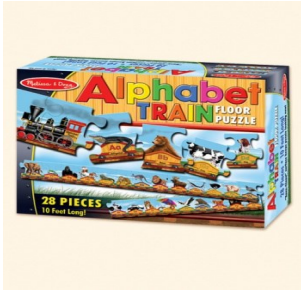

Within the security of trusting relationships, infants and toddlers develop curiosity, initiative, a sense of self, and a desire to explore their world. Adults can foster this development by responding to the young children in their programs with care and respect.

Part 1 of this program, you will learn how to create a climate of trust for infants and toddlers, form partnerships with children, and support children's intentions.

Part 2 provides information on establishing program policies that promote continuity of care.

Part 3, you'll view several extended unnarrated scenes from High Scope programs illustrating strategies for developing supportive interactions with young children.

Children grabbing toys, crying, fighting — problems are bound to happen when very young children share materials and play space. In this DVD program, you will learn about the ingredients that go into an active learning program. You will also learn how High Scope's curriculum content can help you better understand children's growth and learning so you can plan developmentally appropriate activities. In a separate section, the DVD includes un-narrated clips of active learning taking place in actual High Scope settings.



Eating, napping, playing, exploring objects and people — all infants and toddlers do these things but have varying personal routines from day to day. When caregivers provide consistent but flexible daily schedules and caregiving support, they let children know their needs are met, freeing the children to investigate their world.

Part 1 of this program gives you an overview of an infant-toddler daily schedule that includes arrivals and departures, group times, feedings and mealtimes, personal care times, and choice time.

- **Part 2** offers strategies for creating a daily schedule that is stable yet flexible enough to meet young children's needs.

- **Part 3** shows caregivers supporting children throughout the daily schedule in a series of un-narrated scenes from authentic High Scope settings.

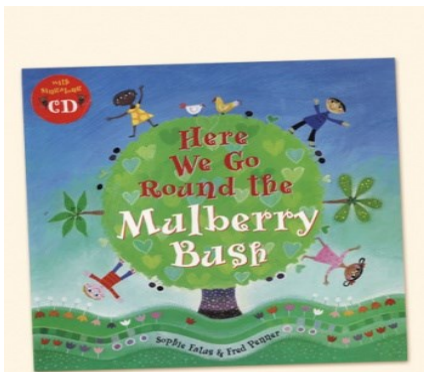

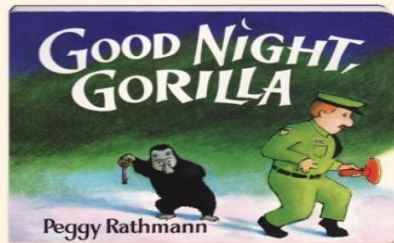
