Working Groups, Committees, Activities, Opportunities – Join Us!

Network with other professions, build contacts and leaderships skills, and help your Chamber to fulfill its mission to enhance business vitality and quality of life in our community.

## **Business Development Group**

Provides education and training opportunities to Chamber members to assist in their growth and success. People who like to network, plan events, coordinate trainings or have skills in business development will enjoy this activity. Programs include: *Lunch & Learn* series, *Business After Hours* & additional training programs as developed.

## **Community Planning & Economic Vitality**

All of our working groups are important, but this one is perhaps the most timely and pivotal to our business vitality and community livability. #### **Chamber Connection**

This is a new networking and peer-support program designed for high-energy, creative business owners and professionals. Members have an opportunity to exchange ideas, products and services and business information, forge collaborations and seek input on prospective innovations. If there is sufficient interest, the Chamber Connection group will meet monthly and will be responsible for planning and scheduling each meet. The Chamber will help promote the program and encourage participation. A dynamic coordinator is needed.

## **Marketing Support Group**

Volunteers with a background in marketing, sales and public relations assist the Chamber director and staff in creating new membership programs, promoting activities and events, advancing the Chamber's mission, and developing new ideas to support business members. Participants may also be involved in the annual Basalt Community Guide & Business Directory and developing new informational packets, posters and flyers as needed.

# "Operation Appreciation"

Just once a year in the Spring, volunteers are asked to help deliver the Chamber's Community Guide & Business Directory to businesses in appreciation of their membership and participation. Time commitment varies.

## **Membership Development & Retention**

Volunteers assist the Chamber's efforts to engage members in activities and benefits that support and enhance their business development. Studies show that active members derive the greatest advantage from their local chambers of commerce programs and are most likely to maintain their memberships and contribute to a lively business community. Activities might include building member benefits and calling members to share Chamber news, information about upcoming events and new benefits. Those interested in being a key player in the Chamber's unique and vital contribution will especially enjoy this group's activities.

### **School-to-Office Program**

Volunteers will work with area schools to develop programs that link students with professionals in mutually beneficial ways. Linkages might include internships, specific projects, mentorships, or short-term engagements that allow students to enhance their resumes, college applications and skillsets. The program is also designed to better prepare upper-class students to make strategic college curriculum choices by exposing them to diverse career opportunities.

#### **Events Strategy & Development**

Event volunteers assist with aspects of planning, promotions, set-up, sponsorships and ticket sales where applicable. The Chamber currently puts on the *Live After Five* Summer Concert Series and various other events, and will collaborate with other local business associations to enhance the vitality of our downtown and other commercial centers. Additional events might include: a *Technology & Education Conference* or a *Meet Basalt Businesses & Entertainment Fair*. If you love to entertain and enjoy creating synergistic connections, this is the group for you.

### Office Support in the Caboose
