The garden will be located in front of the auditorium entrance at Lake Park's West Campus.

The focal point of the memorial will be a large commemorative stone with an engraved bronze plaque. This memorial stone will be surrounded by a tranquil, landscaped garden with a brick walkway which will include several benches, giving individuals or families a peaceful and relaxed setting in which to seek solace.

COMMEMORATIVE BRICK GUIDELINES

The Lake Park High School Memorial Garden commemorative bricks (4" x 8") are available for \$100 each. Two brick categories are available: "Memorial" bricks and "Friend" bricks.

"Memorial" bricks may contain only the following inscriptions:

- "In Honor of" or "In Memory of"
- Legal name of an individual or portion of an individual's legal name
- Year(s) of attendance/service at Lake Park or dates of birth/death

"Friend" bricks may contain only the following inscriptions:

- Legal name of an individual, family, group, or business
- Year of sponsorship donation

Please note that Lake Park High School reserves the right to edit text in the event that the requested inscription does not conform to the above-listed guidelines. In that event, donors will be notified. No religious or political references will be permitted.
