- II. Discussion: Creation of Food Hub working group (learning community, community of practice)
  - a. Agreement to kick off a working group by:
    - i. Funding 6 NC food hub personnel (3 current managers, 3 reps from forming food hubs) to attend the national food hub meeting in Raleigh March 26-28.
    - ii. Followup meeting of these recipients in May with other NC food hub personnel (existing or forming hubs) and those with an interest in learning more about food hubs.
  - b. Note: planned Extension in-service training on the topic of food hubs to roll out later in the year

- a. Food Safety Planning and Work
  - i. Group GAP calls planned for week of Jan 27 with Wallace Center and NCGT partners in anticipation of Group GAP pilots for food hub(s) in NC
- b. Fort Bragg connections and work with dining halls
  - i. Connections have been made between NCGT and base personnel to create and implement localseasonal based menu options
  - ii. Supply chain student work on possible produce consolidation centers for areas near-base
  - iii. NCGT gathering farmer-level data on produce supply in the Base encroachment zone
- c. Grocery model work
  - i. Solidifying DSD vendor-setup processes at stores
  - ii. Supply chain student team work on optimal supply chain routing through warehouse
  - iii. Supply chain student team working on sourcing NC seafood direct to store
- d. Academic/educational update
  - i. Local food supply chain course in place, 6 student teams working with NCGT partners on supply chain challenges
  - ii. Suggestion to do mid-semester evaluation of course using Office of Faculty Development services
