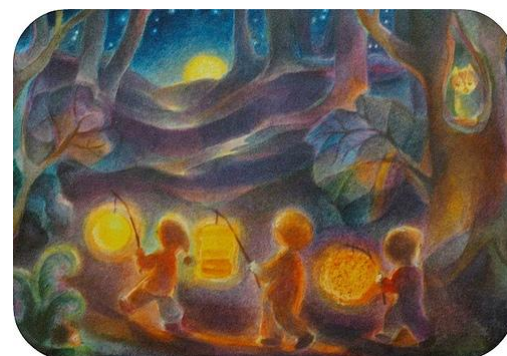

Jingle Baby Doll Workshop

Monday & Tuesday, November 4th & 5th, 9:00-11:00 at The Oak and the Acorn Café

This soft-bodied Waldorf doll is made from 100% cotton flannel and is filled with carded sheep's wool. The hands and feet are made as part of the body, and to cap it off, he/she has a jingle bell sewn securely to his head, inside the hat, which tinkles softly when moved about. Many colors to choose from! The class is taught by Phyllis Gilmer.
