San Mateo County, CA - The County of San Mateo RecycleWorks Program just launched two new courses for business owners, Property Managers, tenants, and Facility's staff in San Mateo County. The courses, "Green Business Practices" and "Principles of Waste Reduction and Recycling," will teach business owners how to save money and learn how to be resource conservation savvy.

The "Green Business Practices" course will cover topics on how to make your business green while learning ways to reduce energy, water and waste, and prevent pollution.
