HOW TO ARRANGE FOR CURBSIDE PICK UP:

1. Tuesday, April 1 through Friday, April 25 at 12 noon
 - Pre-register at City Hall, 30 East Eau Claire Street
 - Show proof City of residency
(driver's license, State ID card, utility bill, bank statement, pay check or government document)
 - Complete and sign Registration Form
 - Provide phone number and/or email address
 - Receive an Operation City Pride brochure that lists all acceptable items
2. Friday, April 25
 - A volunteer will contact you by phone and/or email
3. Saturday, April 26
 - Items need to be at your curb by 8 a.m. (household trash will not be accepted)
 - Payment is due at the time of pick up
 - Cash or checks are accepted
 - Checks made payable to the Boys & Girls Clubs of Barron County
