## LOOKING AHEAD TO 2015

### CONNECTING OUR COMMUNITIES

Chittenden County and Vermont as a whole are on the edge of a transformation for walking and biking. In 2015, Local Motion will work with towns to identify and build momentum for at least three essential connections between communities, like more bike lanes on Williston Road and a safer connection between Burlington and Winooski. We will also support and encourage VTrans as they bring their road design standards into the 21st century, identify priority state highways for wide shoulders, and more.

### SAFE STREETS FOR KIDS

Children deserve the opportunity to get around safely under their own power. In 2015, Local Motion will bring together parents, schools and local governments from Brattleboro to Rutland around a shared conviction that safety for kids comes first. We are working with more than 25 communities to create opportunities for safe walking and biking, starting with bike skills training for 5,000 kids through Kohl's Kids Bike Smart.

### CAMPAIGN FOR A BIKEABLE BURLINGTON

Burlington could be the kind of place where everyone is comfortable biking anywhere in the city. In 2015, Local Motion will unveil a vision for a city-wide network of protected bike lanes and bring together residents, businesses, and others to accelerate the pace of change. With leadership from the Mayor, Burlington can transform our streets and make a truly bike-friendly city a reality.

### THE PROMISE OF THE ISLAND LINE

A well kept secret even in Vermont, the Island Line Rail Trail has the potential to draw thousands more visitors and boost the local economy. In 2015, Local Motion will expand the Island Line Bike Ferry service in the shoulder seasons and launch a network of bike rest areas for recreational and touring cyclists in the Lake Champlain islands and Greater Burlington area.

## BETTER PLACES FOR WALKING AND BIKING


We helped communities redesign their streets for safe walking and biking, with projects in 17 towns in 3 counties that together are home to 25% of all Vermonters.



We kept low income Vermonters rolling, with 321 refurbished bikes and 1,200 bike repairs provided by Bike Recycle Vermont.



We provided event bike parking at more than 60 events, so that nearly 5,000 individuals could choose biking as their means of transportation.



We helped more than 9,000 customers at Local Motion's Trailside Center say "Yes!" to biking, with advice, maps, bike rentals, and more.



We enhanced the Island Line experience, with 100 days of bike ferry service carrying 11,800 riders to the Champlain islands. And 1 marriage proposal!



We brought Kohl's Kids Bike Smart to more than 30 schools in 8 counties, with 15,201 hours of bike skills training for 5,096 Vermont kids.



We organized Vermont's first-ever Open Streets event where more than 2,000 people biked, played, and danced on car-free neighborhood streets.
