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**NOTICE OF APPLICATION PERIOD FOR VACANCIES ON CITY COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES**

The City Clerk's Office is accepting applications to fill upcoming and current vacancies on the following commissions and committees: Planning Commission, Parks & Community Services Commission, the City's appointee to the Napa County Measure A Financial Oversight Committee, and the Napa County Library Commission.

The Planning Commission holds public hearings on proposed development plans, conditional use permits, subdivision maps, and other land use matters, as well as proposed changes to the Zoning Ordinance, Zoning Map, and the General Plan. They assist in preparing amendments to the General Plan and Zoning Ordinance, and preparing specific plans. Applicants should have some knowledge of land use planning, zoning, economic development and community issues in the City of American Canyon. The Commission meets on the fourth Thursday of each month at 6:30 p.m. There are three terms ending December 31, 2014.

The Parks and Community Services Commission serves in an advisory capacity to the City Council about matters pertaining to park development, park and recreation facility use issues, recreation programming and related issues. Applicants for the Parks and Community Services Commission should have general knowledge/interest of park improvements, open space management, facility maintenance, recreation programming and community services. The Commission meets on the second Thursday of the month at 6:30 p.m. There are two terms ending December 31, 2014.

The purpose of the Measure A FOC is to inform the public on expenditures of Flood Protection Sales Tax proceeds generated as a result of the enactment of Measure A. Interested applicants need to have a strong understanding of the type and nature of expenditures associated with a public project of this magnitude and be able to review budgetary documents with a particular emphasis on capital project expenditures. Meetings are held quarterly. There is currently one vacant seat

The Library Commission consists of eight members with three appointed by the Board of Supervisors and five by the Napa, American Canyon, Calistoga and Yountville City/Town Councils. The function of the Commission is to advise the Napa County Board of Supervisors on Library matters. The Napa City-County Library Commission meets the second Monday of each month at 4:00 p.m.
