Internationally renowned Christian apologist and human rights scholar Dr. John Warwick Montgomery and Dr. Angus Menuge, President of the Evangelical Philosophical Society will present on the topic – “Do human rights need religion?” Many philosophers have held that fundamental human rights can be understood independently of God, while others have argued that some version of theism is required. Drs. Montgomery and Menuge argue that only a transcendent foundation in God is sufficient to justify human rights claims. The presentation will begin at 6:30 PM in the Wisconsin Room of the UWM Student Union. There is ample parking in the parking structure beneath the union.

This presentation is intended not just for university students but for adult and youth members of SWD congregations as well. We are very thankful to be in partnership with you in providing a church home away from home for university students on the east side of Milwaukee and providing campus outreach activities.
