Tyler McMiller serves the Lord through The Lutheran Church—Missouri Synod as a GEO (globally engaged in outreach) missionary in Mexico. In this role, Tyler partners with local church leaders and other LCMS missionaries to strengthen the existing Lutheran Church in Mexico through raising up local pastors and lay leaders. Using his musical talents, he also organizes the music in each mission location. Tyler also assists with the publication of a new Lutheran hymnal for the Spanish-speaking world. In addition, he helps coordinate translation projects of theological material used in developing Hispanic pastors.

Tyler was born in Waukesha, Wis., and his home congregations are Elm Grove Evangelical Lutheran Church and School, Elm Grove, Wis., and Santa Cruz (Holy Cross) Lutheran Church, Racine, Wis. At Santa Cruz Lutheran Church, from 2010–2014, he helped translate sermons, played the violin and taught catechism classes. Being a missionary kid, Tyler lived in Chile and Panama for a number of years. He then earned a bachelor's degree in Spanish and history from Concordia University Wisconsin, Mequon. While in college, Tyler played in a Mexican mariachi band (Mariachi Real Azteca) for four years. He also studied in Chile the spring of 2014, where he voluntarily played the violin at Sunday worship services and translated extensively for the Lutheran Church of Chile (ILC). Tyler enjoys playing the violin and guitar, reading Spanish, studying Hebrew for seminary, studying history and volunteering at church.

Please pray for Tyler as he serves in Mexico. Ask God to give him strength and peace as he transitions to life in Mexico, learning the culture of the people so he can effectively communicate the Gospel. Ask God to keep him safe as he travels and serves throughout the country. Please pray for the doctrinal orthodoxy and unity of the Mexican pastors as they struggle against heresy. Pray for the clear preaching of God's Word for the changing of lives and the assurance of salvation for the people of this country.
