

Seller Instructions
Super Scenic 72 Mile Garage Sale
November 16, 2013 (Saturday) 8 am to 2 pm

Thank you for participating in the 2013 Super Scenic 72 Mile Garage Sale. Community sites where volunteers will assist shoppers (buyers) and sellers (vendors) are listed below with volunteers identified and cell phone contact information. Please call **Marge Rooyakkers 386-246-3767** for problems or questions.

Times: Setup on Saturday should occur between 7 am and 8 am. Breakdown of Community Site displays should occur after 5 pm on Saturday or earlier as merchandise is depleted. Raffle tickets will be collected after 5 pm and the **drawing held Tuesday, November 19, 2013**. All sellers are responsible for ensuring A1A remains **super scenic** by leaving **no goods behind** at the end of the event. Remove all trash from areas as well.

Supplies Distribution: On Thursday signs and basic supplies will be distributed or available for pick up to all community site volunteers and/or participants. Sign set up should occur any time Friday evening to announce the event. Sellers are responsible for bringing their own tables, cash change, water and other needs of the day. Community sites are locations with restrooms on site or nearby. To encourage sales at all locations, Friends of A1A is conducting a super scenic raffle that can only be entered at the community sites or online. Discount coupons and flyers of supporting businesses will be at community tables while they last. Flyers with all locations identified with some goods also identified and mapped for shoppers.

Duties:

Green up – make sales and Cleanup – make scenic!

Advise buyers other site locations are found on the maps at community tables.

Additional items needed: May need to bring your own chair; water; sunshade hat; first aid kits (ie bandaids) for minor problems. Extra cash for change as deemed necessary. Weather is expected to be moderately windy with occasional light showers (40% decreasing to 20% late afternoon). Bring your own paper weights for windy conditions – especially at Flagler Beach sites. Protect your goods from water.
