



### **Rev. Michèle Bauermann**

Born in The Hague, she studied music at the Royal Conservatory in The Hague and also graduated from the Central Pentecostal Bible School (now: Azusa Theologische Hogeschool).

Her first ministry started in 1975 in a Dutch Assemblies of God Church in the City of Utrecht, where she served for 10 years

Also involved in the Ministry of Women's Aglow International since 1981, she served in the National Board for 10 years and still is a frequent speaker in Aglow groups in the Netherlands and abroad.

In 1983 she joined the organizing team (CCS) of the Conference Centre "the Bron" in Dalfsen, where she worked as a praise and worship leader, interpreter and speaker in many conferences for more than 25 years.

Since 1985 she travelled as an itinerant missionary to many nations of the world, among which: the Middle East, Thailand, Philippines, Indonesia, India, Sri Lanka, but also South Africa, the Caribbean and the USA and Canada.

In 1993 she became the pastor of an Assemblies of God Church (VPE) in Bunschoten Spakenburg, where in 1997 she started a School for the Charismatic gifts, "Klaar voor de Oogst". (Ready for the Harvest)

From 2000 till 2013 she served as a member of the Mission Board of the Dutch Assemblies of God (VPE-missions).

From 2010 till 2013 she served as a member of the National Board of the Dutch Assemblies of God (VPE, Verenigde Pinkster en Evangeliegemeenten)

In 2013 she left the church in Bunschoten Spakenburg, which she had served for twenty years and is free to minister in the local churches of the Netherlands and International.

Within the Netherlands she speaks frequently in churches of African origin, among which the Redeemed Church of Christ in Nigeria, Shepherds Place in The Hague and the Arc of the Covenant Church in Leeuwarden. She also is connected with The gate of Grace church, a French Speaking African church in Baarn.
