

Position Description for Assistant Race Management Director

The Assistant Race Management Director is part of a race management team responsible for delivering quality monthly club races and the White Rock n Roll (WRNR) signature race.

Race Dates

Races are usually on the first Saturday of the month as follows:

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Duties

- Work with the City of Dallas to obtain permits, reserve the race site, secure police and EMS, and post-race paperwork as required by the City
- Work with the timing company to coordinate timing and bib production
- Set up registration pages and work with the Communications Director to promote races and communicate with members
- Coordinate efforts with the Volunteer Director to ensure races are adequately staffed
- Race day tasks including aid planning, loading/unloading supplies, start line setup, water station setup, awards

Physical duties may include:

- Driving a U-Haul
- Loading and unloading race supplies before, during and after the race
- Purchasing and loading food items into personal vehicle for delivery to clubhouse

Time Commitment

All members of the Race Management Team share race management duties. The Race Management Co-Directors will coordinate duty schedules. However, members of the Race Management Team should plan to be available for race-day eve (Friday at 6 p.m.) truck loading at the DRC Clubhouse (<u>1130 Beachview Street in Dallas</u>) and on race day (Saturday) from 6:00 a.m. to noon.

The various administrative tasks and preparation tasks typically take a couple of hours per month, most heavily within the week to ten days before each race.

Assistant Race Management Directors are subject to the <u>DRC Bylaws</u> and must comply with the <u>Roles and Responsibilities of the Nonprofit Board</u>.
