... Is a friendly phone line staffed entirely by
people with lived experience of mental health
and/or dual diagnosed.

Peer Operators are compassionate,
empathic listeners. They offer support and
validation. They empower callers to find
solutions to their own problems and
concerns.

The Peer Warm Line accepts calls from peers
who are perhaps lonely, depressed, and/or
isolated and want to connect with another
peer. The focus of the discussions are
recovery-based, and the Operators are
motivated to assist callers with information on
and referral to local, state and national
programs and services that may be useful to
them in their day-to-day lives.
