General Information for all North Katanga Mission Teams:

- A passport is required for each team member and must not expire less than six months from your return date.
- Vaccinations and anti-malarial medication will be required.

- People participating on VIM teams to the Congo should be in good health and able to walk moderate distances.
 Housing will be provided in United Methodist guest houses that do not always have access to electricity or
 running water, but are clean and comfortable. North Katanga leaders take the safety and well-being of
 VIM teams very seriously.
- High temperatures will range from the low 80's to the upper 90's during the day and cools down considerably during the evenings.
- In addition to personal costs, team members will be responsible for raising supplies and/or funds to support the specific mission of their team.
