November 8: Setting up a Congregational Health Ministry
Learn how to navigate the complexities of your congregation to work for a healthier family of God! We will talk about who should be on your health ministry committee, what a health ministry looks like, and how to promote health in practical ways throughout the year.

November 15: Now that our Church Members are Home from the Hospital, How do we Continue to Care for them?
OhioHealth Social Workers will talk about what is helpful when folks leave the hospital and how our congregations can help care for church members who have come home

November 22: End of Life Planning and Care
