HENDRICKS AFTER SCHOOL CLUB POLICIES

- All clubs are on a first-come, first-serve basis. There is a limited amount of space in many clubs. Register early!
- Registration must be accompanied with the club tuition, supply fee (if applicable), and one time application fee of \$10 in order to be enrolled. Payment is due in full by the designated deadline:

2nd Trimester: Nov. 17th - Feb. 27th Payment/Registration due Nov. 7th

- Payment for tuition, supply fees, and application fee must be payable to Hendricks. Please place payment in the box at the Receiving Office. Clubs can no longer be billed to your account. A \$10 late fee will be charged for registration after Nov. 7th. A \$25 late fee will be charged for registration after Nov. 14th. Applications will not be accepted after Nov. 14th.
- If a student does not wish to continue to attend a club after the first meeting, he or she is entitled to a refund of TUITION only. Written notice must be submitted within two days after the first meeting or a refund will not be given.
- Teachers will make up any club meetings they miss if the teacher is out of school. If a student misses a meeting, the teacher is not required to make up that day. If a student is absent from school, they may not attend the club that day.
- Students must be picked up promptly when clubs are finished or they will be sent to extended day and charged accordingly.
- The teacher has the right to ask a child to leave the activity if he or she is not demonstrating self-control or following directions. The child will remain in the classroom until the club is dismissed. If the behavior continues, the child will no longer be able to continue in the club.
- Clubs will not meet the first Tuesday of every month due to a faculty meeting (fees have been adjusted where needed).
- Your private lessons are very important to us, it is reserved especially for you, we understand that sometimes schedule adjustments are necessary; therefore, we respectfully request at least a 24 hour notice for cancellations. Please understand that when you forget or cancel your appointment without giving enough notice, we miss the opportunity to fill that appointment time. Since the services are reserved for you personally, a cancellation fee in the amount of your private lesson will apply.
