- 2. Fill out the order form with your name, phone number and the total number of gifts you are sending.
- 3. Enclose \$8 per recipient.
- 4. Mail your order form, order list, and your check to Sisterhood of Temple Sinai.

NOTE: Each recipient will only receive one Shalach Manot gift. Each package is accompanied by a card listing all the contributing families. The basket will be hand delivered to each recipient by Sisterhood volunteers and Temple members during the week of Purim. Israeli soldiers receive their gifts through the Purim Connection operated by ARZA.
