JANUARY 10 & 11, 2015 @ FALMOUTH FIRE DEPARTMENT

APRIL 11 & 12, 2015 @ WEST BARNSTABLE FIRE DEPARTMENT

This is a two-day (9-5) weekend training course that educates potential emergent volunteers and responders to the regional emergency co-sheltering (human & pet) plan in Barnstable County and the various organizations that participate to bring about its success. There will also be discussion on who CCDART is and what our role on the BCREPC (Barnstable County Regional Emergency Planning Committee) involves. In addition, we will be discussing personal and pet preparedness and "go-kits", radio communications, shelter design and set up, registration, and a hands-on MOCK DRILL where all the newly acquired skills can and will be utilized. This is a hands-on training course and participation will be required on both days.

There is a one-time \$25.00 donation (cash only) for the weekend and includes training materials, certificate of completion, light snacks and lunch fare and water, tea and coffee. The fee is non-refundable and is due upon entrance Saturday morning. Pre-registration is required for this training. There is no commitment to join CCDART after this training; however students will be given the opportunity to join the team upon completion and may do so anytime within a year of training. Students who complete this training will be considered potential "Emergent Volunteers" and will be called upon in times of natural disaster here on Cape Cod.
