According to the Massachusetts Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders State Plan, every sixty-nine seconds another American develops Alzheimer's disease. It is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States and the fifth leading cause of death for those 65 and older. One in nine people age 65 and older has Alzheimer's disease, 4 percent under 65 have younger-onset Alzheimer's.

Most care for people with Alzheimer's in Massachusetts is delivered at home by family member and they often must seek community supportive services. Family caregivers often suffer from both physical and mental exhaustion. The mission of Hope Dementia & Alzheimer's Service is to provide information, education and support for people with Alzheimer's disease or a related dementia—and the families and professionals who care for them.

"Better access to and knowledge of services can help caregivers provide a higher quality of care to their loved ones as the disease progresses, often postponing the need for more costly long term residential care," said David Rehm, president & CEO, HopeHealth. "The emotional stress of caregivers can be alleviated when they are given clear, simple information about the disease and its progression and services available in the community. Improving access to caregiver interventions can improve caregiver health and decrease reliance and financial strain on our health and social service systems."
