COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

HYANNIS, MA – The Town of Barnstable Growth Management Department (GMD), the lead agency for the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), is pleased to announce the availability of CDBG funds estimated at \$296,000 plus any roll over funds for the 2014 program year (July 1, 2014 – June 30, 2015).

Funds can be used for eligible projects that benefit Town of Barnstable residents with incomes at or below 80% of the Area Median income. HUD limits funding for public service activities to 15% of the entitlement or an estimated \$44,000.
