Cape Cod Volunteers is holding a training for staff and volunteers of Cape Cod nonprofits who want to learn about volunteer recruitment through using the Cape Cod Volunteers website. The <u>Cape Cod Volunteers</u> website provides an online matching tool for nonprofits to list their volunteer opportunities and a place for Cape Codders to search for openings that match their interests.

The training is designed to provide a brief overview of the website followed by an opportunity to complete a posting with CCV support so that nonprofits can walk away with a finished product. This is also an opportunity to learn more for those organizations that are already on the CCV website and have questions or want to feel more comfortable using the online tool.
