Year-Round Programs

Continuing Connections (Afterschool Club)

This program is designed for children and young adults with high functioning autism, Asperger's Syndrome, and other related social challenges. We provide opportunities to make friends, have fun, and learn new skills in fun activities, such as art, music, cooking, sports, and games. Activities are designed to promote communication and help foster social skills development. Continuing Connections meets every Tuesday afternoon from 3:30pm to 6:00pm and is open to ages 7 though 18. Our fun, caring, and engaging staff receive training in team building activities, social skill instruction, and proper safety policies and procedures.

Price: \$20/week (next session starts Fall 2014)

Social Adventures (I & II)

Social Adventures is designed for children and teens with high functioning autism, Asperger's Syndrome, and related social disorders. Children receive clear instructions in the areas of social skills and social thinking strategies and have the opportunity to practice these skills in structured, small-group activities. Staff provide social coaching throughout each session, with a focus on friendship and fun for all! Social Adventures meets every Saturday from 3:30pm to 5:30pm.

Bridges to Independence

Summer Camp 2014

Summer Camp at The Bridge Center offers 9 weeks of incredible opportunities for children, teens, and young adults to enjoy recreational and skill building activities in a supportive and nurturing environment that is accessible to all. We offer a wide variety of programs to meet their interests and needs, and our professionally trained staff ensure that everyone in attendance is engaged, having fun and making friends!

Camp Connect

Camp Connect is designed to meet the developmental, social, and behavioral needs of children and young adults between the ages of 4 and 22 with Asperger's Syndrome,

High Functioning Autism and related disorders. Camp Connect offers traditional recreational camp activities such as swimming, archery and horseback riding as well as therapeutic activities such as team-building exercises and social skills groups. Each activity is designed to promote communication and socialization skills and are adaptable to meet goals outlined in a child's IEP. Children are carefully placed in small, clinically-sound groups to enhance their experience. As with all our camps, friendship and fun are core elements of all activities. Due to the therapeutic and goal centered nature of Camp Connect, children must be enrolled for the full session.

Dates: Full Session- 6/23/14 to 8/1/14 (\$3750) Lite Session- 8/4/14 to 8/22/14 (\$1875)

Camp Discover

Camp Discover is open to all individuals between the ages of 4 and 22 with special needs, regardless of the nature or severity of their disability. Campers enjoy therapeutic recreation and traditional playtime in an accepting environment that is fun and accessible to all. Every week campers will have opportunities to make friends while growing more confident and

becoming more successful in skill building activities. Campers are provided limited, extensive or pervasive supports (depending on their individual needs) and are placed in groups following a careful assessment by our trained, professional staff.

Dates: 6/23/14 to 8/22/14 (1 week sessions, \$495/week)

Camp Summit

Camp Summit creates opportunities for success among children and young adults with moderate to severe behavioral and/or emotional disorders. Typical diagnoses serves in this program include ADHD, PTSD, ODD, anxierty, Bipolar Disorder, mood disorders, etc. Our counselors are trained to provide a positive behavioral system that creates structure for children who have struggled or failed at other camps. Staff work closely with campers in a safe and supportive environment to build and reinforce positive responses. Our low camper to counselor ratios allows each camper to receive the coaching and guidance they need to build self-confidence, be successful and enjoy a summer camp experience that is safe and fun for everyone. Camp Summit is open to participants aged 4 through 22. Dates: 6/23/14 to 8/22/14 (1 week sessions, \$575/week)

Horse Camp

Horse Camp is a program designed for campers who love horses! Horse camp gives each camper the opportunity to participate in many horse related activities with their peers. Activities include learning all about grooming, leading, horse education, care and safety, horse related crafts and fun activities. Each camp day also includes a 45 minute riding lesson taught by a certified riding instructor. This program offers a fun and interactive environment in a small group setting and is open to children and teens between ages 8-16. Dates: Week 2 (6/30 to 7/3), Week 6 (7/28 to 8/1),

Week 7 (8/4 to 8/8), Week 8 (8/11 to 8/15), Week 9 (8/18 to 8/22). Price: \$500/week

Inclusion Horse Camp

Inclusion Horse Camp is an opportunity for campers with and without special needs to work together while learning about horses. This program touches on education, safety, nutrition, and animal



Care. In addition, participants will develop the skills of riding, grooming, leading, and much more! Inclusion horse camp is designed for children and young adults between the ages of 8 and 16. **Price: \$500/week

Dates: Week 3 (7/7 to 7/11), Week 4 (7/14 to 7/18)

Horse Camp Sibshop

Our Horse Camp Sibshop is a week-long camp program designed for siblings of children with special needs. This program offers the opportunity for siblings to meet others in the community who face some of the challenges and joys of being a brother or sister to a child with special needs. This camp gives each participant the opportunity to make fiends, work together, and bond with each other while learning all about horses and participating in horse related activities.

Dates: Week 5 (July 21 to July 25, \$500/week)

VIP (Volunteers in Progress)

The volunteer in progress program is designed for teenagers interested in developing leadership skills. They will have the opportunity to engage in a supervised and structured camp experience, learning skills and exploring possible job or volunteer opportunities. The VIPs spend part of the day developing skills necessary to lead younger campers in daily activities such as sports and cooking. For the remainder of the day they enjoy recreational activities within their group, focusing on teamwork, communication and social skills. Participants will also have the opportunity to swim in our Olympic-sized pool every afternoon.

Extended Day

All of our summer camp programs run from 9am to 3pm, Monday through Friday. We offer extended day from 3pm to 5pm every Monday through Thursday. Price is \$25 per day.
