# The objectives of the forum are:

- To develop an understanding of the philosophy of Care, Welfare, Safety, & Security with children.
- To incorporate the concepts & strategies in Non Violent Crisis Intervention to aid in the continuity of a child's support & care.
- To learn to implement successful strategies to help diffuse or de-escalate potentially dangerous behaviors especially when a child begins to show anxiety.

This is an introduction to aid participants in understanding some steps in managing disruptive behavior. It is not a full training in Nonviolent Crisis Intervention.

Ann Marie Salvatore M.Ed., CAGS, is the trainer for this workshop. For eight years, she has been a CPI Instructor for Barnstable Public Schools. Training's completed consist of: *Trauma Informed Care: Implications for CPI's Crisis Development Model; Autism Spectrum Disorders Training Program and Nonviolent Crisis Intervention Training Program.* Mrs. Salvatore is a Special Education Teacher working at Barnstable United Elementary School. She has worked in the district since 2002 with Students with Special Needs. Prior to Barnstable her experience has included working for New England Center for Children, the May Center and the Cape Cod Collaborative.
