UNLOCKING ADDICTIONS: EMD THE ADDICTION PROCESS

Addictions swallow up the lives of those who suffer from them. New Mexicans suffer in inordinate numbers from life stealing addictions. Social Workers see this on a daily basis and new skills for treating this huge problem are needed ASAP. EMDR therapists have discovered ways to use this Therapy to eliminate addictive behavior and help individuals reclaim their lives.

This workshop will examine the neurobiological underpinnings of addiction, how traditional treatments work or don't work and how EMDR approaches the problem. Targeting the positive affect that the addict experiences and unhooking it from the destructive behavior is a treatment protocol being used by EMDR therapists. In this presentation we will demonstrate how this is being used and what the implications for treatment are. EMDR trained clinicians will benefit the most from this presentation, however, others who are interested in the topic are encouraged to attend.
