Projects not yet completed must have reached a point sufficient to permit judgment of merit. You are encouraged to nominate your own organization.

AWARDS

Awards may be made to organizations or individuals in any or all of the following areas of achievement:

- **public programs** (including education, exhibition, interpretation),
- publications
- historic preservation
- community documentation and collaboration
- new technology (e.g. website development, blogs, audio tours)
- Board Vision
- advancement of regional history

Nominations reflecting work in 20th century documentation, or re-interpretation of collections are strongly encouraged; nominations of collaborative or regionally-focused projects are especially welcome.

CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

Nominations will be judged on the evidence of quality, creative use of resources, and long-term significance, by a peer jury of professionals, representing the history, museum, archives and academic fields.
