

**Who can apply?**

Girls who will be 14 years of age or older at the time of the GSLI (by October 16, 2014) are eligible to attend.

**Do participants have to be Girl Scouts to apply and attend?**

While girls do not have to be members to apply at their local Girl Scout council, we do ask that girls register as Girl Scouts before the start of the event. [Register](#) for Girl Scouts today!

**When is it?**

GSLI will run from 1 p.m. on October 16, 2014, through the evening of October 18, 2014.

**Can girls participating in the GSLI do other things at convention?**

Girls' and chaperones' fees include admission to the national convention, and girls are encouraged and welcome to attend the business sessions, exhibits, celebrations, and conversations when the GSLI is not in session.

**How much does it cost?**

The GSLI requires group registration (girls and chaperones) through the Girl Scout council, and the fee includes entrance to the National Council Sessions, Conversations of Consequence, Hall of Experience, plenaries, and some meals, as well as all GSLI sessions and materials. Onsite registration will not be available. Housing and additional recreation are not included.

*Girl's fee: \$250.00 Chaperone's fee: \$250.00*

**Where do girls stay?**

Girls and their chaperones will stay in the same hotel as their council convention delegation. Rooms for GSLI participants will be booked by their Girl Scout councils.
