Who: WESTSIDE RESCUE and friends. We are sponsoring another in a series of community pet clinics.

This one is being held the day before the SUPERBOWL, AND we are especially inviting pit bull and bully breed owners in need and their dogs...hence the name. We are honored this day to be joined by fellow rescuers from **FRESNO BULLY RESCUE**, who will help us serve those in attendance and share with you a deeper understanding about how to be the best possible guardian of pit bulls and bully breeds. Come meet them and learn how you can make Fresno a better place for bully breeds. Of course, ALL dogs and cats are welcome.

What: A vaccine clinic, plus a whole lot more! Called "NO WAY STRAY," the goals of this series of NO WAY STRAY clinics we started in late 2012 are (1) to provide resources to our community for properly identifying their dogs and cats so that they never become strays or end up at a shelter without identification and (2) to provide access to vital vaccines for dogs and cats, along with information AND financial resources to everyone for spay and neuter services for their animals that are not yet fixed. We have too many stray, sick, pregnant, neglected animals in our community. *Help us change this!* 

**What we will do:** Provide rabies vaccines for dogs and cats, along with distemper / parvovirus vaccines for dogs and FVRCCP vaccines for cats. **NOTE:** ALL UNVACCINATED PUPPIES AND KITTENS MUST BE CARRIED IN YOUR ARMS OR BROUGHT TO THE CLINIC IN CARRIERS. We will also provide you with information on the benefits of licensing your animals, as well as making it easy for you to do just that.

Where: Holmes Playground at 212 N. First St. (First St. and Huntington Blvd.) in Fresno

When: Saturday, Feb. 1, 2014 from 11 AM to 2 PM A call or e-mail ahead of this date to let us know you will be in attendance will help our volunteers plan ahead to accommodate everyone in attendance.

Please tell us in your message how many animals you have and what kind of help you need for each.

Why: We want to help low-income households to provide proper vaccines and spay and neuter services for their companion animals. No one who wants to provide good care for their companion animals, as well as improve the community through responsible spay and neuter practices, will be turned away. (Westside Rescue DOES reserve the right NOT to help those who are breeders or seeking to make a profit off their animals.) We want to remove Fresno from the top of the charts that list cities with the highest numbers of homeless animals AND cities that kill the most animals in public shelters because of these high numbers.

Donations will be gratefully accepted to offset the cost of providing these services.
