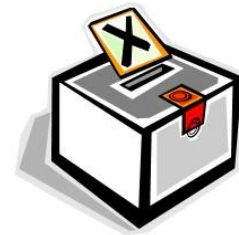
2014 Meet the Candidates Forum

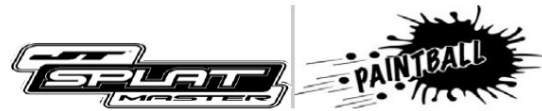

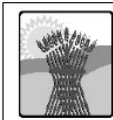
