

Christopher is an internationally known parish minister, lecturer, composer and conductor whose works encompass children's music for liturgy and catechism plus a wealth of material for all liturgical celebrations. Born and educated in England, Christopher earned his degree in music from Bristol University. He served as director of music at Clifton Cathedral in Bristol and director of music for the Clifton Diocese.

Christopher resides in Los Angeles, where he is director of music and worship at St. Paul the Apostle Church, the Paulist Parish in Westwood. He is also a member of the National Association of Pastoral Musicians. He travels frequently, giving workshops, retreats and lectures on liturgy, music and children's worship. We are happy to welcome him here to prepare us for Lent and help us be better Ministers. He will lead us in our reflection at three Paulist Foundations in the diocese: The Catholic Information Center, St. Luke University Parish, and the Cathedral of St. Andrew.
