A look at schools using Flight Simulation Labs

Flight Simulation Labs have been integral to the success at <u>Farnsworth Pre K-4</u> and <u>Farnsworth 5-</u> <u>8</u> Aerospace Magnet Schools here in Minnesota since 2003. Both were under performing schools. Both were on the list of schools to be closed. Today, both schools have enrollment waiting lists of several hundred students each. And both schools now score near the top in the St. Paul School District. The Flight Simulation Labs were not the sole reason for this success, but they served as a cornerstone in the successful efforts to turn these schools around.

In 2013, after experiencing successful results at both Farnsworth Pre-K and Farnsworth 5-8 Aviation Magnet programs, the St. Paul School district decided to complete the Aerospace Magnet "circuit" by bringing Johnson High School into the Aerospace Magnet format. Beginning this fall, students can remain within the Aerospace and STEM track from Pre-K all the way through the 12th Grade.
